

Draw a Red Fox Step by Step



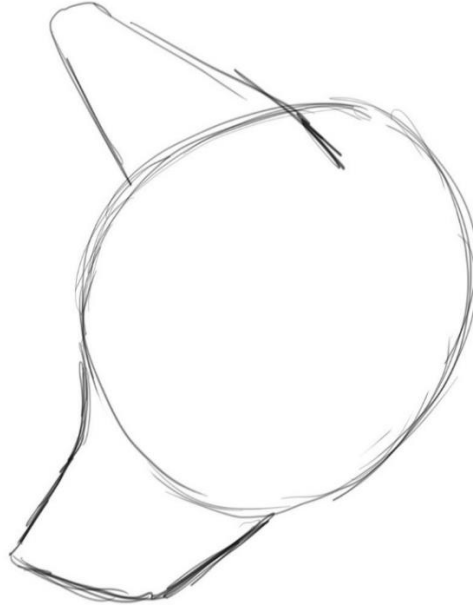
1. Start by looking for shapes in the fox's head. Do you see the round shape of its face? Draw a circle for the face.



2. The fox's muzzle is shaped like a rectangle. Or – it may look more like a trapezoid to you. Remember, there is no right or wrong answer -- it's whatever shape you see. Draw that shape for its muzzle.



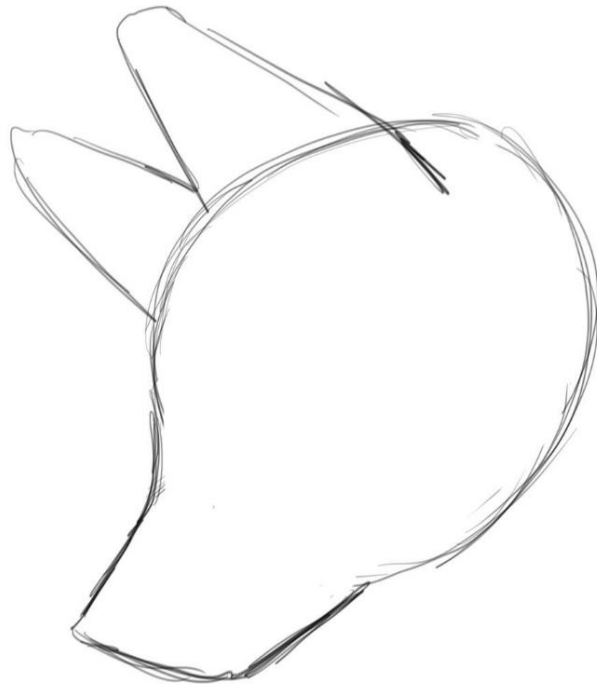
3. Add the first ear. Notice the ear is a triangular shape. The left side of the triangle rests on the circle for the face. The right side goes down past that line.



4. Time to add the second ear. This ear is another triangle to the left of the first ear, closer to the muzzle. Notice the left side of the ear touches the circle; the right side touches the other ear.



5. Time to erase some of the lines we don't really need. First, erase the line between the face and the muzzle.



6. Now erase the line between the right ear and the face.



7. Time to add the eye. Notice that the eye has two straight lines and one curved line.



8. Now add the iris (the colored part of the eye). Be sure to leave a white spot for the catchlight. The catchlight is where the light reflects off of the eye.



9. Next, add the nose. The nose is oval-shaped. Color in the nose, but be sure to leave a white highlight.



10. Time to add the mouth and a few marks on the muzzle.



11. The fox needs a neck! Add the neck by drawing lines for fur. The top of the neck should meet the top of the head. The lower line for the neck should meet the head a little above the muzzle.



12. Erase the line between the head and the neck.



13. A red fox has reddish fur on most of its body, but it has white fur on its mouth, chin, and chest. Draw a line to separate these colors.



14. Add a few lines to the ears to indicate the inside of the ear.



15. Finally, add some fur to your fox. Draw the fur as shorter lines, since the fox has short hair. Make the lines go in the same direction the fur would go.
